Dear Fellow Servant,

We are inviting you and a group of your leaders to join us for the Jerusalem Council II (JerusalemCouncil2.com) scheduled for August 12-14, 2025, in Athens, Greece. As the Church enters its third millennium - prophetically understood as the Age of the Spirit - we invite Christian leaders worldwide to gather at a sacred assembly of prayer, repentance, discernment, listening and then acting on what the Spirit is saying to the Church.

The first Jerusalem Council addressed the foundational question: "What does it mean to be a Christian?" in the context of the relationship between Jewish law and Gentile inclusion in the early Christian community. Now, two thousand years later, as humanity stands at the threshold of an age where artificial intelligence challenges our deepest assumptions, we gather first in repentance for our divisions and failures, and then to hear what the Spirit is saying to the Church about an even more fundamental question: 'What does it mean to be human?'

We gather first in repentance. Where the first Jerusalem Council sought to give direction to both Jews and Gentiles, Jerusalem Council II seeks first to pray and hear and then provide spiritual leadership in the Third Millennium Church. In this Age of the Spirit, amid unprecedented technological and cultural transformation, we gather to fall on our knees together in global communion for the Great Commission.

We gather second to realign. We will attune our hearts in prayer to the Spirit's voice speaking through all nations and traditions represented in the Jerusalem Council II. Just as the first Jerusalem Council bridged profound divisions between communities, we now gather to bridge the distance between human and divine wisdom, between our technological capabilities and our spiritual essence, between what we have created and who we are created to be.

We gather third to recommit. We invite you to join in this historic moment of communal prayer and holy listening as we cross the threshold of two millennia. Here, where Paul once proclaimed the Unknown God, let us gather in humility and expectant hope to seek the Spirit's guidance on humanity's deepest questions as we cross into the third millennium.

Upon the completion of our collective six sessions together, our seventh session will be conducted at the Acropolis where we will pray for “the nations” and then go together to Mars Hill, where we will pray and believe for the Unknown God to be known in every people group in the third millennium.

Will you rearrange your schedule and join us? If you are unable to attend, would it be possible to send an ambassador?

We have limited the number of attendees to 490 considering Jesus’ teaching to forgive seventy times seven. We come to Jerusalem Council II (JerusalemCouncil2.com), in the spirit of forgiveness, seeking to synergize our energies and efforts toward the completion of the Great Commission.

We invite you to gather with us at JCII on August 12-14, 2025, in Athens, Greece, as we repent, realign and recommit for the Spirit to show us together a successful pathway to this Third Millennium, and to know “What the Spirit is saying to the Church?”
