JERUSALEM COUNCIL

In the **Jerusalem Council I**, in the mid-first century, less than two decades after Jesus's resurrection, Jewish followers of Jesus, honored His Great Commission by welcoming Gentiles.

In the **Jerusalem Council II**, 2000 years after Jesus' resurrection, we as the Global Church reaffirm Jesus' Great Commission through our synergistic commitment to share with all peoples groups the eternal hope God has made available in Jesus Christ.

In the **Jerusalem Council I**, the leaders said, “it seemed good to the Spirit and to us” (Acts 15:28). In essence, the Church concluded and has continued to “hear what the Spirit says to the churches” (Rev 2:7, 11, 17, 29; 3:6, 13, 22).

In the **Jerusalem Council II**, just as **Jerusalem Council I** recognized, our mission is grounded in Scripture, in the good news of what Jesus Christ has done, and empowered by the Spirit, we must serve the global unity of Jesus' movement and our mission to the world.

The **Jerusalem Council I** was moved by the Spirit to become global and now at the **Jerusalem Council II**, the Global Church must synergize together to finish the Great Commission.

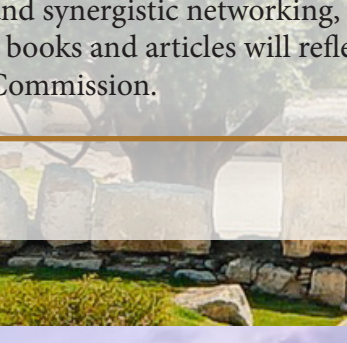

We are living in one of the grandest times in history, with the Lord calling this generation to communicate the glorious Gospel of our resurrected Savior, Jesus Christ. It is imperative that we hear His words clearly and share them in ways that people all over the world can understand and respond to “the Unknown God.” As we celebrate the close of the second millennium and look ahead to the third, this generation is poised to become **The Church of the Third Millennium**.

When Peter came to Jesus and asked, “Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother when he sins against me? Up to seven times?” Jesus answered, “I tell you, not seven times, but seventy times seven.” He was teaching Christ-followers to live in the spirit of forgiveness. In order to further demonstrate the spirit of forgiveness, the JCII grand total will be 490 Christ-followers (missional strategists, NT scholars, church leaders, leading pastors, Bible translators, and church planters).

The registration cost is \$700 per person, plus hotel and roundtrip air travel, and includes JCII resources, two leadership luncheons, two world-class dinners and special times of fellowship.

The Jerusalem Council II will offer up to 100 scholarships. These scholarships will cover the hotel and registration costs and be based upon: 1) A Third Millennium Leadership Criteria established by the JCII Planning Team; 2) Strategic location, especially among the hardest unreached peoples; and 3) A form of partnership with the recipient pays half of the registration cost and underwrites the roundtrip airfare and visa cost (if applicable).
